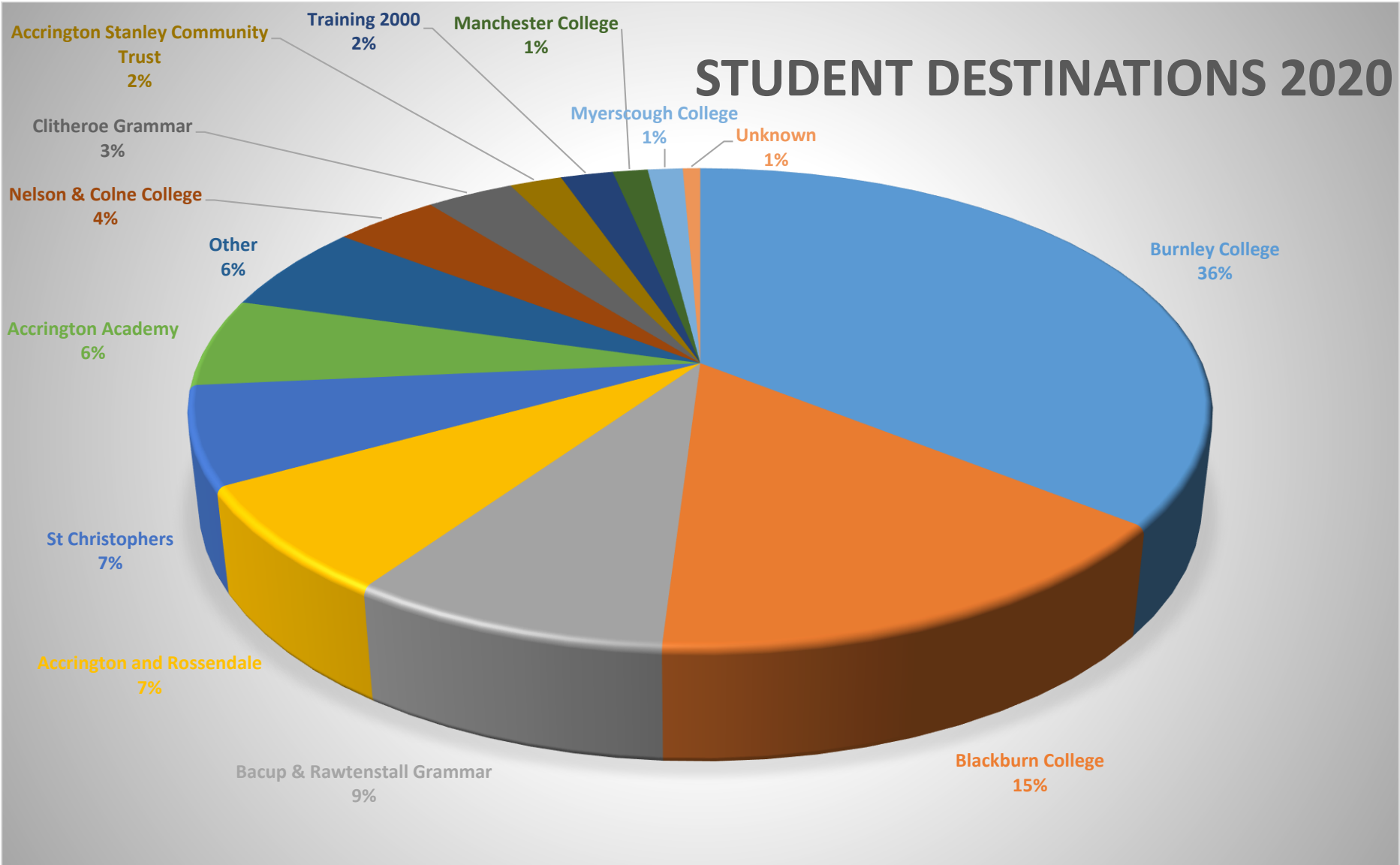
Tables of outcomes are listed to the left show:

  - Apprenticeships for School Leavers start at Level 2.

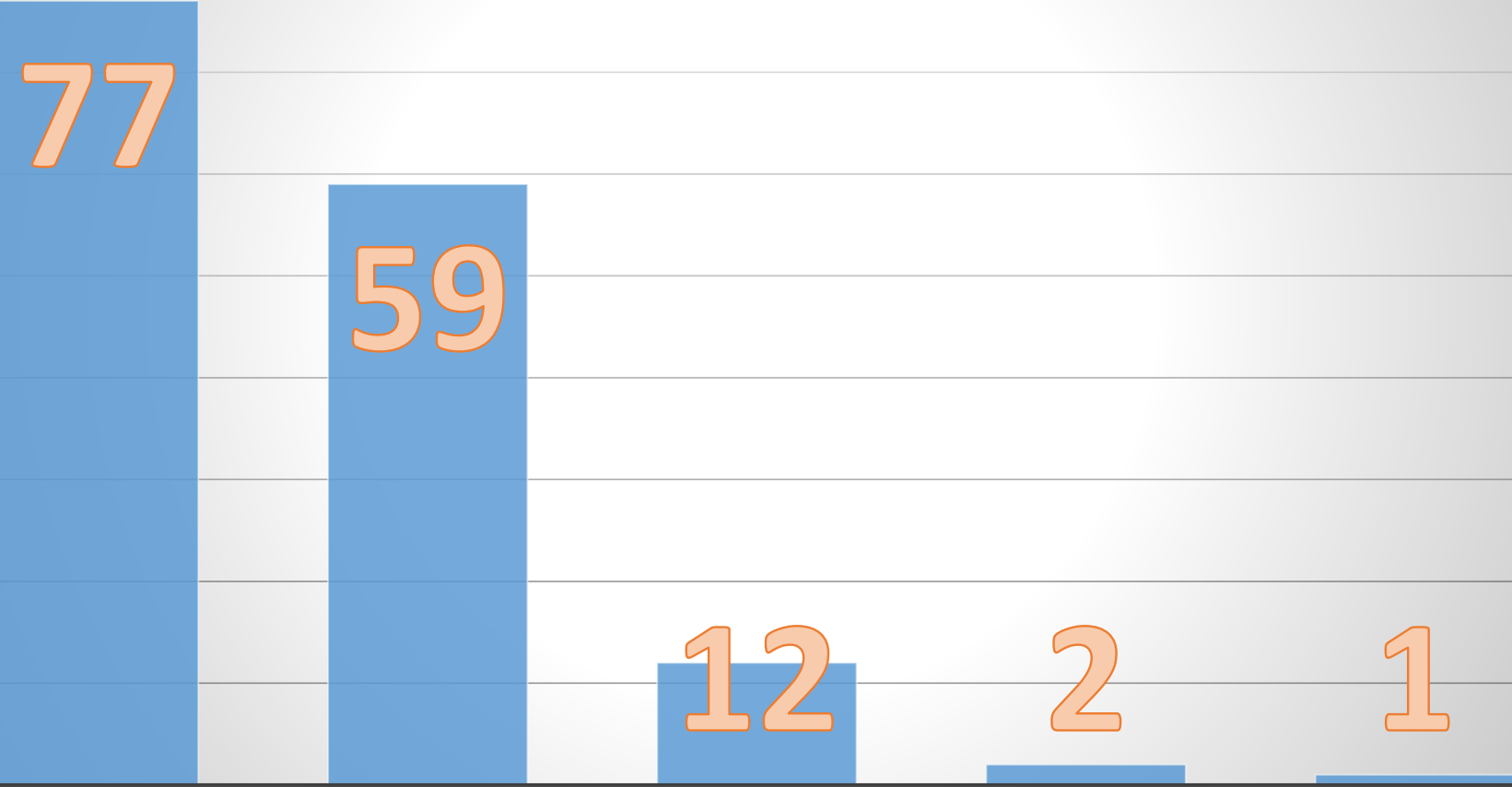
