POST OF TEACHER OF MODERN FOREIGN LANGUAGES (PERMANENT 0.4)

Thank you for your interest in the position of permanent teacher of modern foreign languages (0.4) from Monday 12 April 2021 or 1 September 2021. The successful candidate will be teaching Spanish up to KS4 and it would be an advantage if you can offer some KS3 French. MFL is increasing in popularity, year on year, with the number of pupils choosing GCSE Spanish and French also rising.

The Hollins serves an area of relative deprivation, with 58% of our students coming from E/E* areas of overall multiple deprivation and the prior attainment of our students is below average. However, examination results at Key Stage 4 show that attainment and achievement are good with the vast majority of our students making excellent progress.


The most recent Ofsted inspection (December 2017) recognised The Hollins as “a good school in all areas”. Particular strengths were our SMSC provision and care, guidance and support of pupils, which were outstanding.

The Hollins currently has a pending application to form a Multi-Academy Trust with another secondary school and two primary schools. If successful, we hope to convert on 1 September 2021.
